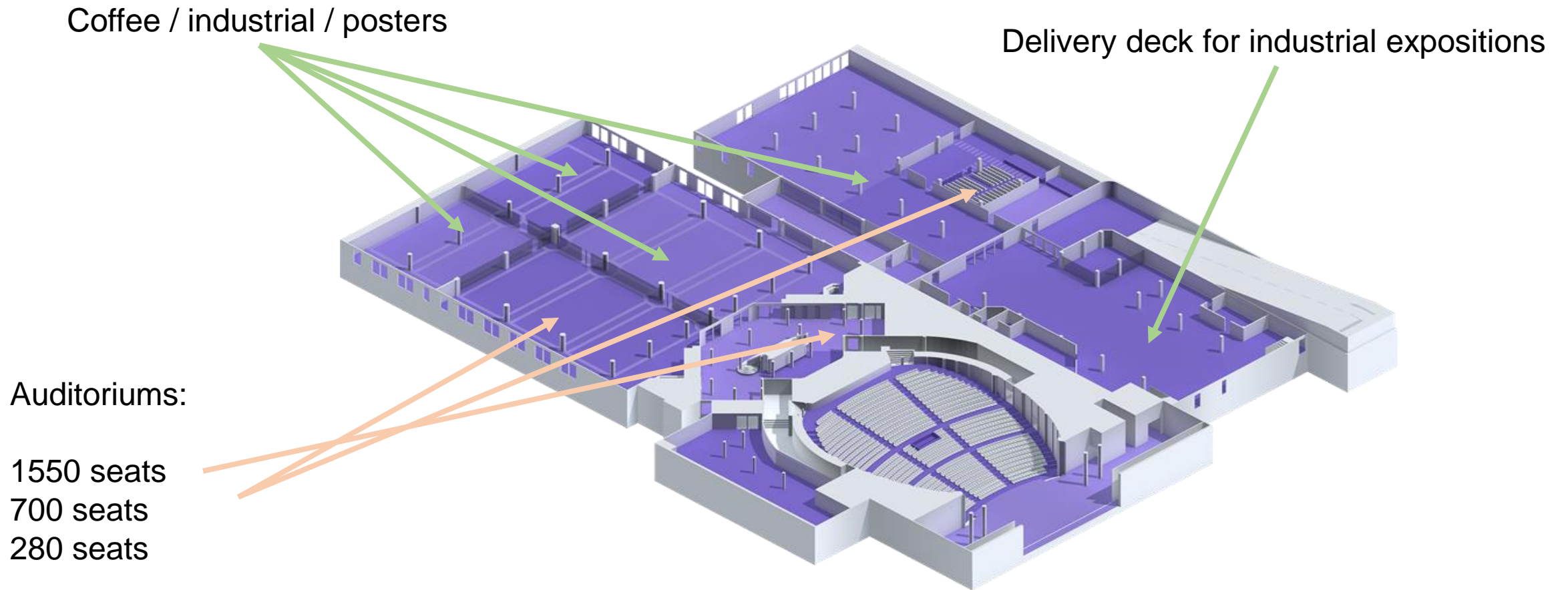
Underground building Sea side in 3 levels



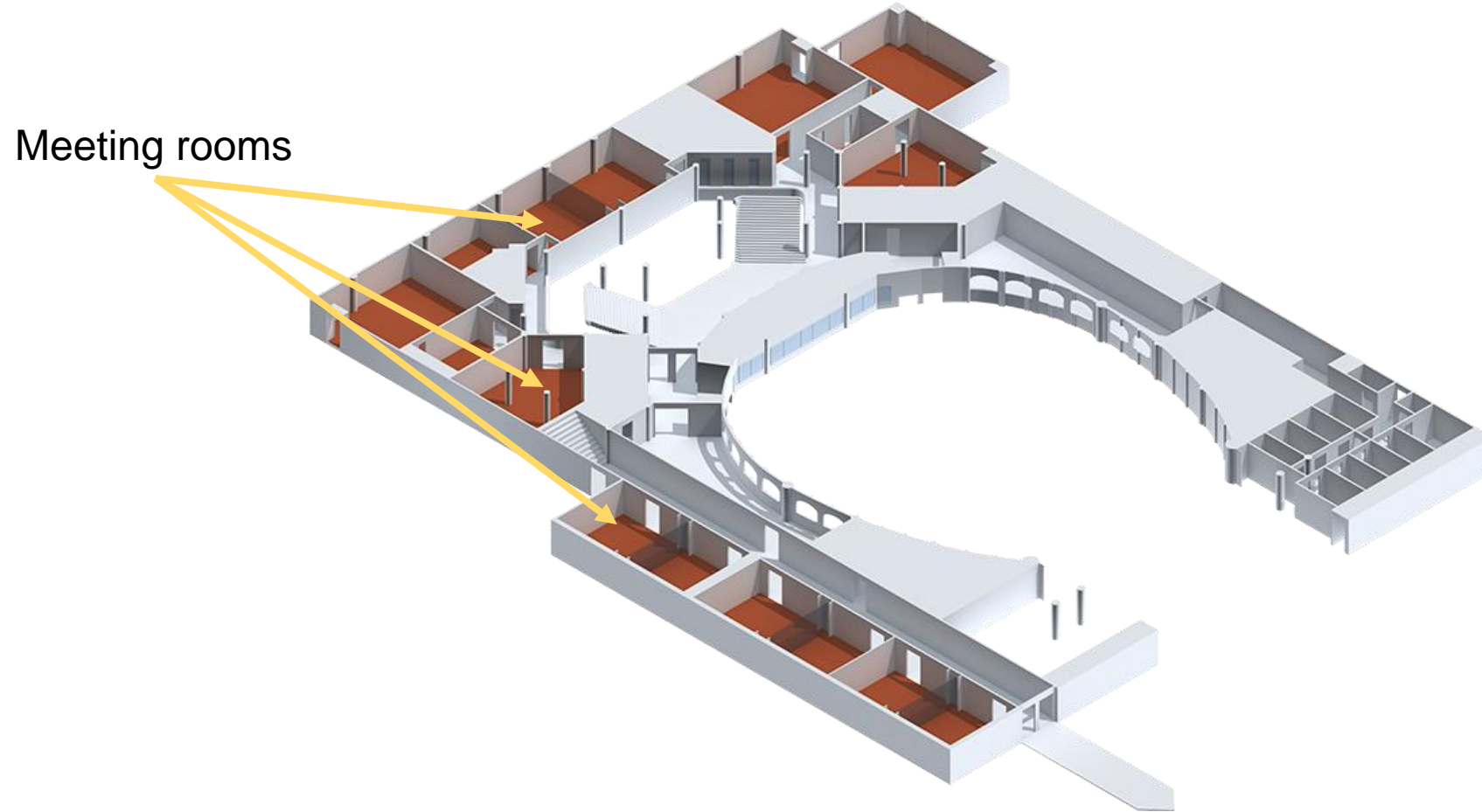

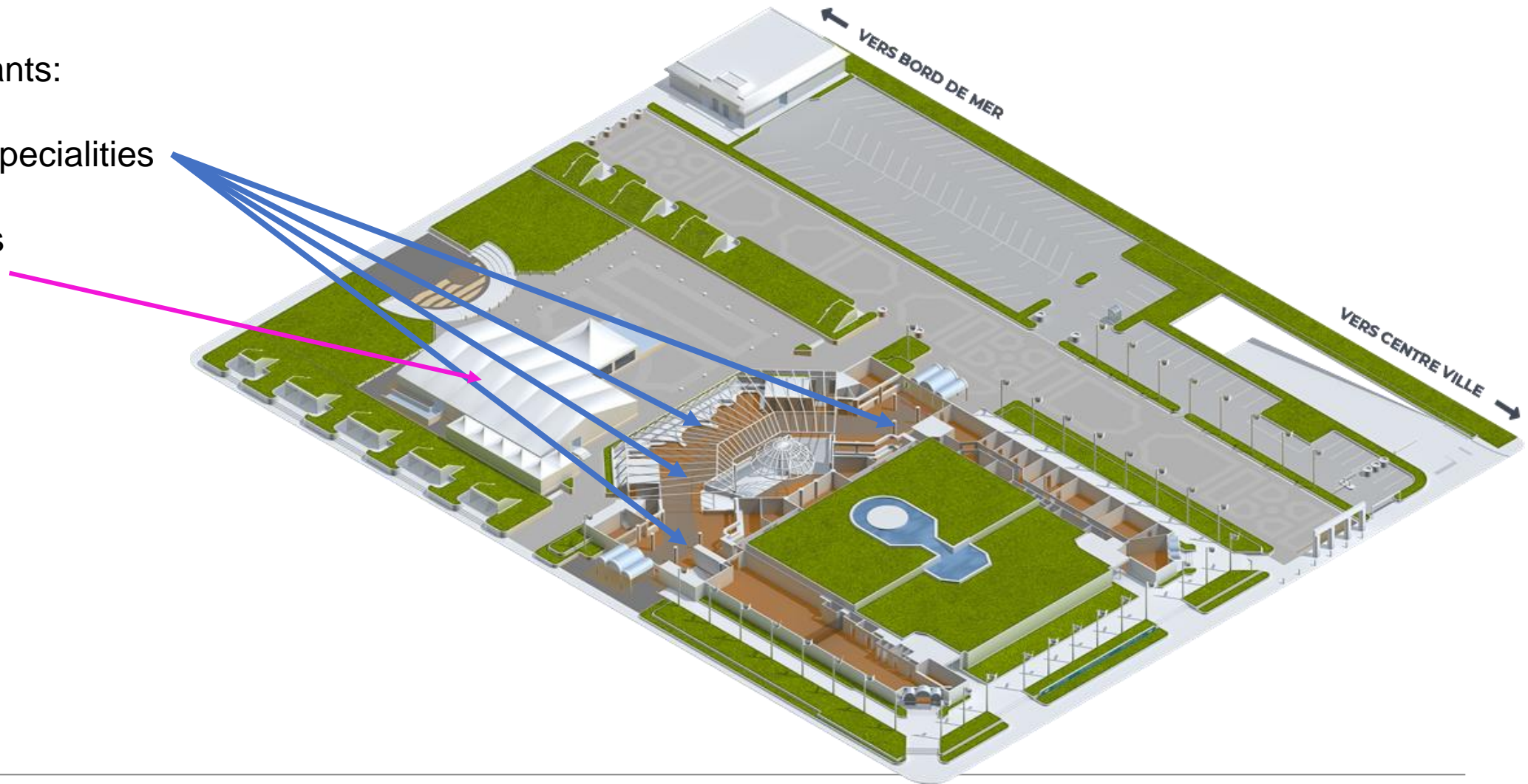

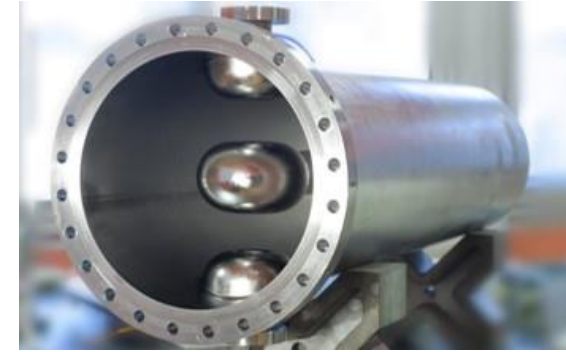
